NOTE: If after game #13, there are two teams with one loss each, the team having the most games will receive the Bye in Game 15. If two teams have played the same number of games, they will draw for the Bye. If one team has played the same number of games, they will draw for the Bye.

NOTE: If after game #13, there are three teams with one loss each, the team having played the most games will receive the Bye in game #15. If two teams have played the same number of games, they will draw for the Bye. If all teams have played the same number, then all will draw for the Bye.
