UMPIRE REQUIREMENTS FOR DBB TOURNAMENTS



- 1. **Sub District and District Tournaments:** Each umpire shall be a registered DBB umpire.
- 2. **State Tournaments:** Each umpire shall be a registered DBB umpire.

Each umpire shall be recommended by the State Umpire in Chief

3. **World Series:** Each umpire shall be a current registered umpire for a minimum of not less than two (2) consecutive years, including the present year. The umpire shall also have one (1) State Tournament to meet the criteria. The State Tournament requirement can be met in prior years. The State Tournament requirement will be waived in cases where no state tournaments are held.

Exception: Local umpires from the World Series host area are exempt from the two-year consecutive registration requirement if the umpire calls in a current year State Tournament (if State Tournaments are held in the host state). Umpires who previously registered and called in a State Tournament but do not have two present consecutive years will meet the State Tournament requirement.

UMPIRES <u>MUST BE RECOMMENDED</u> BY STATE UIC AND APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL UIC:

- 4. Each umpire being considered for a World Series must commit to the following:
 - a. Arrive at the World Series site in time to attend opening ceremonies (if held).
 - b. Be available from opening day (usually on a Friday) until the end of play on Monday. Umpire cuts are usually made on Monday. Games will be held on Tuesday with the IF game on Wednesday morning.
